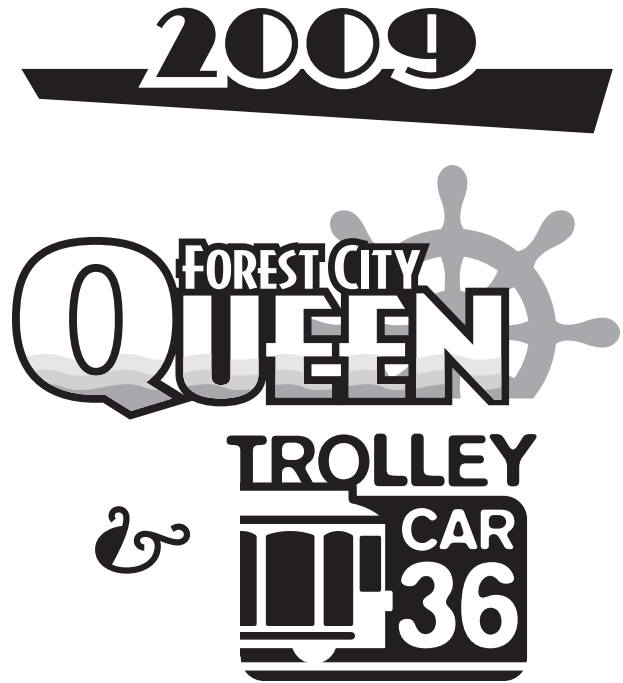

The newly refurbished Trolley Car 36 makes its way from the Trolley Station in Riverview Park along Madison Street, beside the scenic Rock River Recreation Path, makes a stop for a brief visit to the Sinnamon Greenhouse, then turns around at Symbol and returns to the station.
